Walsh Construction is bidding, as a prime contractor, Project No. 800-557, Enhanced Treatment and Site Upgrade (ETSU) Program Phase 1B Project for Union Sanitary District. The project consists of the construction of four (4) new 155-foot diameter secondary clarifiers in the footprint of the existing administration and control buildings. Each secondary clarifier includes a dedicated scum pump station. Construction of a new Mixed Liquor Distribution Box, which distributes mixed liquor to each secondary clarifier. Construction of a new Return Activated Sludge (RAS) and Waste Activated Sludge (WAS) Pump Station to provide sludge pumping for the proposed secondary clarifiers. Construction of a new common Effluent Facility including new Chlorine Contact Tanks (CCTs), Elutriation Pump Station, Union Effluent (UE) Pump Station, Emergency Outfall Dechlorination System, and Old Alameda Creek (OAC) Pump Station.
